

Print out on thick paper or thin card. Please make sure the paper is not too thick to tear easily if caught behind the cat's leg or on a twig etc. Write your phone number on in Biro.

Bend the collar round into a loop (collar) shape. You'll need to use double sided tape or glue such as Pritt stick to secure the "B" end to the back of "A". If the collar quickly disappears, apply a second one. Once the collar has been on the cat for 48 hours, allow another 7 days before neutering. Please only use this method in conjunction with scanning for a chip.
